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Art and Design	Drawing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To look at the work of artists and their practice and discipline - To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products - Copy an original print - Use a variety of materials, e.g. sponges, fruit and blocks - Demonstrate a range of techniques, e.g. rolling, pressing, stamping and rubbing.
Geography	Key question - How do the seasons change? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To name the 4 different countries that make up the UK. - To begin to understand and use N,S,E,W,
Music	Hampshire Music Service – Cold as Ice <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - exploring duration - exploring, responding to and recognising patterns of long and short sounds. - noticing, responding to steady beats in music heard and performed. - exploring, responding to and recognising simple structures including beginning, middle, end and the use of introduction and repetition.
Physical Education	Gymnastics - exploring shapes and sequences. Real PE – Key skills jumping, balancing and coordination.
RSHE/ HeartSmart	Get HeartSmart- Don't Forget to Let Love in! Let love into our hearts. There are different types of touch. Differentiate between the truth and lies that are spoken over us or about us. Appreciate the ways in which we are all unique. There is a choice in spending and saving. Different ways we can take care of ourselves every day. Reflect on ways to let love into our hearts.
